Day 1 - Your Chauffeur Guide will meet you at the hotel and proceed to Kandy.

- MAWANELLA SPICE GARDENS experience an aromatic introduction to Sri Lanka's spice trade and the role spices play
  in both culinary delights and traditional healing practices.
- A guided tour explaining the cultivation methods, medicinal uses, and cultural significance of different spices such as cinnamon, cardamom, pepper, cloves, nutmeg, vanilla.
- Arrive & set on a city tour in Kandy.
- TEMPLE OF TOOTH RELIC Nestled close to the to Udawattakele Sanctuary, The Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic is one
  of the most important shrines of Sri Lanka. Also named as Dalada Maligawa, a place of worship for Buddhists in Sri
  Lanka and around the world. Apart from its religious significance, the temple is a center of cultural and historical
  importance in Sri Lanka.
- PERADENIYA BOTANICAL GARDENS a spacious 147-acre natural extravaganza consisting of more than 4000 species of plants, and 10,000 varied kinds of trees, incidentally serves as the largest garden in Sri Lanka. The unique and rarest collection in these gardens is the Giant Bamboo of Burma which grows 12 inches each day to a height of 40 meters. Apart from this other amazing collections include the Javan fig tree, Cannonball tree, Double Coconut Palm, and about 200 other varieties of palm trees and a versatile collection.
- Check in to Earls Regency hotel in Kandy.

- DAY 02
- After breakfast proceed to Nuwara Eliya
- En route RAMBODA FALLS one of the highest waterfalls in Sri Lanka, cascading down a series of rocky outcrops amidst lush greenery and tea plantations. Surrounding the waterfall are tea estates offering glimpses of local life and culture in the hill country of Sri Lanka.
- En route TEA FACTORY VISIT –
- A guided tour of the tea factory explaining the various stages of the process of Ceylon Tea. This includes withering, rolling, fermenting, drying, and sorting the tea leaves. Learn the different types of tea produced (black, green, white, etc.), their characteristics, and the factors that influence tea quality such as elevation, climate, and soil conditions. At the end of the tour, experience tea tasting sampling different varieties of freshly brewed tea. Allowing you to appreciate the unique flavors and aromas of Ceylon tea.
- Check-in to Grand Hotel in Nuwara Eliya.
- DAY 03
- After breakfast set on a city tour in Nuwara Eliya .
- MOON PLAINS Moon Plains a picturesque plateau situated at an elevation of around 2,000 meters above sea level, offers panoramic views of rolling hills, tea estates, and distant mountains, providing a serene and breathtaking backdrop. Experience the open expanse of Moon Plains and soak in the natural beauty of mother nature.
