Day 1 - Your Chauffeur Guide will meet you at the hotel and proceed on tour

- **DAMBULLA CAVE TEMPLES** - A UNESCO World Heritage site renowned for their cultural and historical significance. These ancient caves, dating back to the 1st century BC, house a remarkable collection of Buddha statues and exquisite frescoes spanning several centuries. The site offers not only a glimpse into Sri Lanka's rich Buddhist heritage but also breathtaking views of the surrounding countryside, making it a must-visit destination for anyone interested in history, art, or seeking a tranquil cultural experience amidst stunning natural surroundings.
- **HIRIWADUNA VILLAGE TOUR** - offers a unique glimpse into rural Sri Lankan life, providing you with an authentic and immersive experience in a tranquil village setting. During the tour, visitors typically engage in activities such as bullock cart rides through paddy fields, boat rides on a picturesque reservoir, and guided walks through the village. Along the way, you will encounter friendly villagers going about their daily routines, offering insights into traditional farming practices, local crafts, and possibly even enjoying a home-cooked meal prepared with fresh ingredients sourced from the village.
- **MINNERIYA NATIONAL PARK** - Minneriya National Park is home to the world's largest known gathering of Asian elephants. During this period, herds of up to 350 elephants are seen at the 8,890-hectare park within a few square kilometers of the Minneriya Tank. The Best time to visit of Minneriya National Park is between July and October, coinciding with the dry season in Sri Lanka's North Central & Eastern provinces. Minneriya National Park is the ideal park for people who want to see Asian wild elephants.
- **Check – in to Sigiriya Jungles.**

- After breakfast, visit lions rock and proceed to Kandy.
- **SIGIRIYA ROCK** – An ancient rock fortress and a UNESCO World Heritage site that stands as a testament to the island's rich history and architectural prowess. Rising dramatically from the surrounding plains, Sigiriya is often referred to as the "Lion Rock" due to the lion-shaped gateway that once guarded the entrance to the royal palace atop the summit. Explore the fortress complex, which includes well-preserved ruins, exquisite gardens, and stunning fresco paintings on the rock walls. The ascent to the top involves climbing a series of staircases and pathways, rewarding adventurers with breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding countryside and distant mountains.

Arrive & set on a city tour in Kandy.

- **CULTURAL DANCE PERFORMANCE** – a vibrant and colorful display of traditional Sri Lankan dance and music, This cultural performance offers a captivating glimpse into the island's rich cultural heritage. The show features a variety of traditional dances each characterized by elaborate costumes, rhythmic drumming, and energetic choreography. In addition, you will find a lively and engaging atmosphere, providing a memorable experience that highlights the diversity and beauty of Sri Lanka's cultural traditions.
- Check-in to Earls Regency Kandy.

- **After breakfast,**
- **TEMPLE OF TOOTH RELIC** – Also named as Dalada Maligawa houses the Sacred Tooth Relic of the Buddha, which is highly venerated by Buddhists worldwide. The temple represents the rich cultural heritage of Sri Lanka. Its architecture, dating back centuries, showcases intricate craftsmanship and design. Apart from its religious significance, the temple is a center of cultural and historical importance in Sri Lanka.
- **PERADENIYA BOTANICAL GARDENS** (Optional) - a spacious 147-acre natural extravaganza consisting of more than 4000 species of plants, and 10,000 varied kinds of trees, incidentally serves as the largest garden in Sri Lanka. An amazing collection of flora and fauna include the Javan fig tree, Cannonball tree, Double Coconut Palm, and about 200 other varieties of palm trees and a versatile collection.
- Return to Colombo.
