- **GANGARAMAYA TEMPLE** The Gangarmaya Buddhist Temple sits in walking distance from the beautiful Lake Beira. The religious significance of the temple attracts locals and travelers alike. Fusing elements of Chinese, Indian, and Thai style of architecture and design, the temple is also an architectural marvel.
- LOTUS TOWER One of the most unique structures in Colombo. At 350M tall the Lotus Tower is tallest selfsupported structure in South Asia and the tallest skyscraper in the Sri Lanka, rising towards the skyline giving you panoramic views of the city.
- OLD DUTCH HOSPITAL Established in the 17th century, the Old Dutch Hospital is one of the oldest and most well-preserved buildings in Colombo. It was built to provide medical aid to the workers of the Dutch East India Company. Although the building served many different purposes over the years, it has now been turned into bustling hub as a restaurant and shopping center.

RED MOSQUE - Jami UI-Afar is a great mosque sitting in the middle of busy commercial streets of Colombo prominently stands out with its Red and white striped color, almost like a candy! Built by Habibu Labbe Saibu Labbe, the mosque is one of the many culturally rich places to visit in Colombo. A dreamy synthesis of Indian, Indo-Islamic, Neoclassical, and Gothic styles of architecture can be seen here - a true cultural gem.

INDEPENDENCE SQUARE – Independence Square in Sri Lanka is a significant landmark located in the heart of Colombo. The design of the building is based on the Magul Maduwa (Celebration Hall), of the Kingdom of Kandy. The Independence Memorial Hall is a national monument in Sri Lanka built for the commemoration of the independence of Sri Lanka from British rule. Visitors to Independence Square can explore the lush gardens and pathways surrounding the memorial, which provide a serene and reflective atmosphere amidst the bustling cityscape.

NATIONAL MUSEUM – The National Museum of Sri Lanka, located in the capital city of Colombo, is the country's largest museum and a prominent cultural institution. Established in 1877, it showcases a comprehensive collection of artifacts and exhibits that span Sri Lanka's rich history and cultural heritage. Visitors to the National Museum can explore a wide range of exhibits, including ancient royal regalia, intricate traditional masks, exquisite sculptures, and artifacts dating back to prehistoric times. The museum's collections also feature items from the island's colonial period, illustrating its diverse cultural influences over the centuries.
